(pronouns that are doing something—Flavors the verb)

I -Yo	We - Nosotros (as)
You -Tú	You (friend) - Vosotros(as)
You (formal) -Ud	You (formal) -Uds .
He - Él , he -Ella	They (m) – Ellos, They (f) - Ellas

I have the ball.

Possessive Pronouns

Describes who owns something—gender/plural agrees with the item being owned, NOT the owner

Mi (s)	Nuestro (a, os, as)
Tu (s)	Vuestro (a, os, as)
Su (s)	Su (s)

It's MY ball!

Es MI pelota.

Start with what you "have"	Using subject pronouns and TENER! (irreg. Yo/boot)	Tell me "whose" that person is using Possessive Pronouns and SER!(verbo loco)
