Regular Present Progressive. An action in progress, right NOW! **-ING**

Limpiar	minus AR	+ ANDO = Limpiando	Estoy Limpiando:	<u>I am</u> cleaning
Hacer	minus ER/IR	+ IENDO = haciendo	Estoy haciendo :	<u>I am</u> doing
Vivir	minus ER/IR	+ IENDO = viviendo	Estoy viviendo :	<u>I am</u> living

KEY: This verb form has 2 parts. BOTH are necessary, just like in English... how dumb does "I sleeping" sound? You mean I am sleeping!
